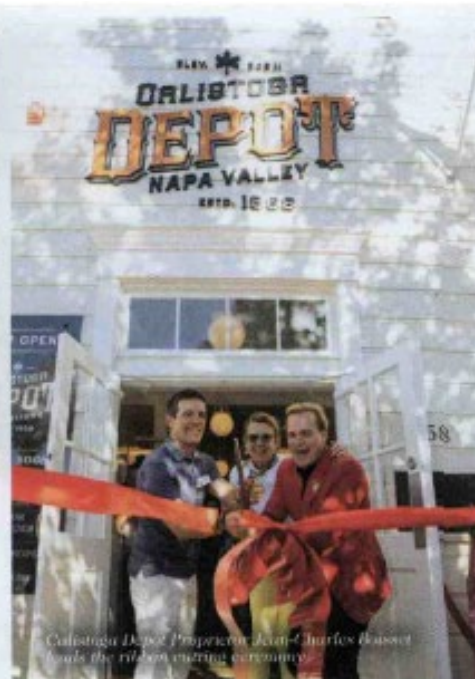

CALISTOGA DEPOT OPENS PHASE ONE OF HISTORIC LANDMARK'S RENEWAL

Built in 1868, the historic Calistoga Depot, California's second oldest train station, opened its doors to reveal the first phase of its renewal—Calistoga Depot Provisions, a gourmet delicatessen, modern mercantile and wine shop featuring local, artisanal products, gourmet goods and prepared foods. The grand opening was celebrated with a ribbon cutting ceremony, hosted by Jean-Charles Boisset, Mayor Chris Canning, and the Calistoga Chamber of Commerce. The Depot will also have a phenomenal wine selection highlighting Calistoga and Napa Valley favorites and rarities, available by the glass or bottle, as well as an outdoor patio and bar with select local beers, ciders, limonades, and more in a serene courtyard that features a pizza oven.
