October 10, 2013, more than 100 Merlot-producing wineries from California, Oregon, Washington and around the world will join together to celebrate #MerlotMe, a month-long, global social media event spotlighting the world-class nature of the noble Merlot varietal. Merlot Month will kick off with two grand Merlot tastings to be held on October 10th in San Francisco and Austin. It will also include Merlot-focused winemaker dinners, special in-winery Merlot flights, in-store tastings and Merlot-paired restaurant menu items throughout the month.

Building on the success of his acclaimed #CabernetDay and #ChardonnayDay events, which reached more than four million people through social media channels, sommelier [Rick Bakas](#) will be the online ambassador for Merlot Month. The event will utilize the #MerlotMe hashtag, with rebelmouse.com/merlotme serving as the online hub for all Merlot Month-related information.

The flagship offline events for Merlot Month will be October 10 Merlot tastings in San Francisco and Austin. The San Francisco event will feature twenty wineries, and will be held at the Observation Post at the Presidio from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. Participating wineries will be pouring their signature Merlot bottlings and special library offerings, accompanied by light appetizers, against a panoramic backdrop of the Golden Gate Bridge, the Palace of Fine Arts, Alcatraz and the Marin Headlands.
