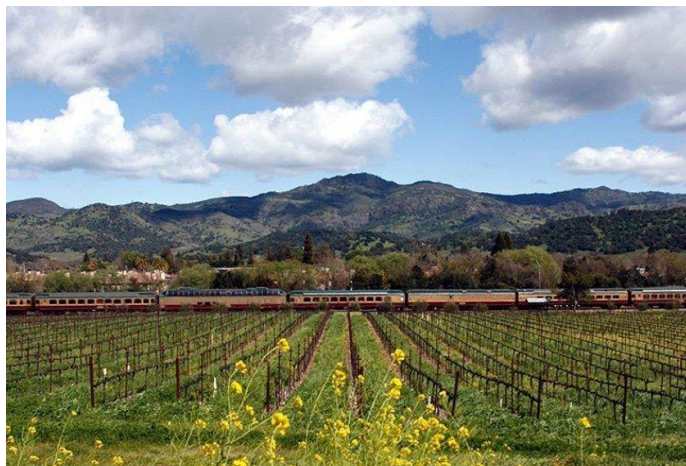


Napa Valley Wine Train Launches Program in Partnership with Local Wineries

Additionally, they even have access to the winemakers as they will be present to discuss the pairings and tasting notes in full detail.

The inaugural Private Reserve wine dinner will roll out on Friday, August 26 from 6 p.m.-10 p.m. and offer wines from Raymond Vineyards.

Jean-Charles Boisset, president of Boisset Family Estates and owner of Raymond Vineyards, will be available at the guests' convenience to mingle and chat.

They will also collaborate with Napa Valley Wine Train's executive chef Donald Young to create the bespoke paired menu. Essential sample menu items include porcini dusted filet of beef paired with Raymond's Generations Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley 2013, grilled duck sausage paired with **JCB No 22 Pinot Noir Sonoma Coast 2013** and Pacific Smoked Salmon Carpaccio paired with **LVE Chardonnay Napa Valley 2014**.
