Boisset Collection acquires Wattle Creek

Wattle Creek Winery and Boisset Collection have announced the reopening of the Wattle Creek tasting room in Ghirardelli Square in San Francisco.

The addition of Wattle Creek and its tasting room to the Boisset Collection occurred in April, adding wines from the Alexander Valley to the Boisset portfolio.

Wattle Creek Winery will continue to produce cabernet sauvignon, sauvignon blanc, and the Triple Play red blend as well as viognier, muscat, pinot noir and merlot.

Winemaker Matt Michael remains as consulting winemaker to ensure continuity of wine style, with consistent vineyard sourcing in the Alexander Valley and Sonoma County.

Wattle Creek wines are offered to guests visiting the tasting room as the Classic Tasting for \$15 or the Reserve Tasting for \$25.

"We are honored to have been entrusted by the Williams Family to continue their vision for Wattle Creek Winery and its tasting room in Ghirardelli Square," the new proprietor, Jean-Charles Boisset, said. "The Williams have been dear friends of ours for several years and we always dreamt of finding an opportunity to do more together."

The newly redesigned Wattle Creek Winery is open to the public daily from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Saturday, and 11 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Sunday. The tasting room is at 900 North Point St. in Ghirardelli Square, San Francisco.
