



Oakville Grocery in Oakville Undergoes Renovations & Enhancements

Store Closed for Improvements until the week of January 25, 2021

OAKVILLE, CA (January 11, 2021) — The Oakville Grocery & Wine Merchant in Oakville, CA, the gathering place for Napa Valley locals and visitors alike since its founding in 1881, will be temporarily closed for renovation and enhancements to continue the improvements to quality, service and selection since its purchase by Jean-Charles Boisset in January 2019..

The new and improved store will re-open with week of January 25th with an expanded cheese and charcuterie offering in a new display case at the front of the store. Additional improvements to the central kitchen island will improve the speed of service and culinary options available. Finally, new grab and go containers will increase convenience and selection.

The improvements will be made always with an eye to maintaining the historical authenticity of the beloved General Store at the heart of the Napa Valley.

During the construction, to-go and curbside pick-up orders will not be available at the Oakville location, but oakvillegrocery.com will continue to ship orders of wine and Oakville Grocery staples. Oakville Grocery in Healdsburg remains open 7 days per week, from 7:30 AM to 3:30 PM.

Since purchasing the Oakville Grocery, Boisset has focused on increasing the assortment of locally-sourced, artisanal and sustainably-produced food and wine, expanding the selection of local wines, enhancing the food, beverages and coffee through improved ingredients and providers, created the Oakville Wine Merchant and 1881 Napa Museum, and developed a comprehensive range of Oakville Grocery products in collaboration with local partners.
