Dark red in the glass, this wine opens with distinct aromas of dark fruits and black currants rounded out with hints of vanilla and candied violets. Our 2012 Red Room Napa Valley Red Wine offers bountiful flavors of blueberries and boysenberries with black currant and caramel. Rich and dense upon the palate, this wine has a velvety texture and satisfying finish.
