2013 BLANC DE NOIR BRUT CARNEROS

While Agoston Haraszthy was most recognized as being the Father of California viticulture, he was also the father of six illustrious children. His third son, Arpad, spent over two years in France learning the craft of sparkling wine and later became the first to introduce Méthode Traditionelle sparkling wine into California winemaking. Arpad's sparkling wine, Eclipse, was one of the most celebrated in the nineteenth century; we pay tribute to his legacy through this Brut sparkling wine of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes.

With grapes harvested from the famed Carneros region, this sparkling wine highlights the subtle and more delicate attributes of Pinot Noir. Made in the Méthode Traditionelle, this beautiful Brut is a delightful expression of Carneros terroir.

This supple wine showcases succulent aromas of honey and baked pear with hints of toasted pie crust and a touch lime zest that balances the flavors. It is elegant and complex, round on the palate, and a true celebration of the grace and beauty of sparkling wine.
