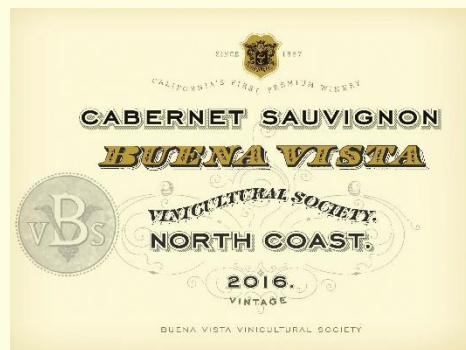

With its roots so deeply ensconced in the foundations of California's coastal appellations, Buena Vista Winery is again introducing wines from the North Coast. The North Coast wines include a diverse array of varietals that celebrate the diversity of California's terroir and the contribution of Buena Vista to establishing the California wine world.

This delightful Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from vineyards in the Fountaingrove District, Sonoma Mountain, and Alexander Valley – all part of California's distinctive North Coast appellation.

The 2016 vintage across California was a near-perfect growing season. A mild winter and spring along led to warm days and cool nights in the summer, and grape growers were able to maintain ideal acid levels with balanced, concentrated fruit flavors

The 2016 North Coast Cabernet Sauvignon opens with aromas of small, dark fruits and black cherry juice. Flavors of black currant and cherry are accented with a touch of black pepper. This is a medium-bodied wine with velvety tannins and a plush mouthfeel that is made to be enjoyed now and paired with hearty dishes.
