ABOUT THE VINTAGE

The 2016 vintage across California was a near-perfect growing season. A mild winter and spring led to warm days and cool nights in the summer and grape growers were able to maintain ideal acid levels with balanced, concentrated fruit flavors.

CONVERSATIONS WITH THE WINEMAKER

The Chardonnay grapes are grown in a single vineyard in south Napa. Due to its proximity to the San Pablo Bay, the winds provide a long, cool growing season that highlight the grape's natural acidity.

TASTING NOTES

This Sparkling wine opens with lovely floral notes. A kiss of honey leads to flavors of Gala apple and stone fruit that spread across the palate. This is a refreshing Sparkling wine with a touch of citrus zest on the finish.
