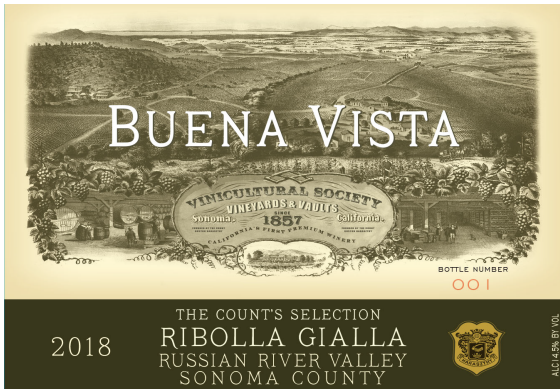

VINICULTURE SOCIETY

The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society was formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy, to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards. The Vinicultural Society has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The Vinicultural Society explores noteworthy, obscure varietals, vineyards and the incredible terroir of Sonoma. Being true to our heritage, Buena Vista Winery presents to you our Count's Selection Ribolla Gialla.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2018 vintage was a near picture-perfect growing season that began in late February followed by a mild Spring yielding uniform grape clusters. Temperatures remained moderate to cool throughout the season with 2018 being considered one of the coolest vintages of the past decade. The cooler temperatures allowed for a longer hangtime, resulting in an even and temperate harvest maintaining ideal acid levels and balanced concentrated fruit flavors.

TASTING NOTES

The Ribolla Gialla is a white Italian wine grape originally from northeastern part of Italy. The aromas of tangerine, tropical fruit, and lemon zest emerge from the glass. On the palate this wine is layered with notes of beeswax, baked apple and thyme. This is a dry medium bodied wine with rich mouthfeel balanced by bright acidity and a lingering finish.
