WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Sonoma County. In keeping with the adventurous spirit of Buena Vista's founding, we are proud to bring you this delicious 2018 Count's Selection Syrah.

Our 2018 Syrah was produced entirely from fruit grown in the Old Winery Vineyard, located just a stone's throw from the historic Buena Vista Winery. This vineyard lies atop gradually sloping soils contained within the boundaries of Agoston Haraszthy's original Buena Vista planting. The Huichica Loam soil series provides an ideal environment for expansive root growth, with drainage allowing for naturally restrained vines.

TASTING NOTES

A deep ruby color, this Syrah opens with dark fruit aromas with a waft of clove. Dense blackberry and cassis flavors coat the palate in this medium-bodied wine with layers of cocoa and black pepper. With supple tannins and well-balanced acidity, the finish is long and satisfying.
