Old World winemaking heritage meets Central Coast terroir in this vibrant DeLoach Vineyards Pinot Noir. We take great pride in producing distinctive wines that highlight the unique nuances of each appellation, while at the same time nourishing the land with eco-friendly viticulture and minimally intrusive winemaking. The fruit for this luscious Pinot Noir was carefully selected from premium vineyards on California's Central Coast during mid-October.

TASTING NOTES

A bright ruby color, our 2018 Central Coast Pinot Noir opens with vibrant red fruit aromas of Bing cherry, fresh strawberry and rhubarb. Delightful flavors of raspberries and blueberries mingle with cardamom spice and notes of rose petals. This finely textured and medium bodied wine highlights balanced acidity and finishes with a silky mouthfeel.
