Our Chateau Buena Vista Cabernet Sauvignon celebrates and honors Buena Vista's indelible presence and significant contributions to the California wine world. Inspired by the Count's influence on the foundation of Napa Valley, where he trained and inspired many young winemakers that would go on to found some of Napa's most acclaimed historical wineries, such as Charles Krug, Buena Vista has returned to Napa Valley, where Cabernet is the King, if not the Count.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

2019 was a near picture-perfect growing season that began in late February followed by a mild Spring yielding uniform grape clusters. Temperatures remained moderate to cool throughout the season with 2019 being considered one of the coolest vintages of the past decade. The cooler temperatures allowed for a longer hangtime resulting in an even and temperate harvest.

The grapes for this Grand Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon were hand harvested between October 23 and October 26 before being fermented in open top fermenters and aged in 66% new French oak barrels for 20 months before being bottled unfiltered.

TASTING NOTES

A dark purple color in the glass, this 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon entices you immediately with aromas of fresh strawberry, cherry and cranberry with notes of cocoa and earth. Hazelnut, chocolate and notes of fresh mint and red currants enhance the juicy red fruit of this full-bodied wine. The finish is persistent and nicely balanced with lush round tannins.
