The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society was formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy, to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards. The Vinicultural Society has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The collection of wines explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Sonoma County.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Named for the wife of the Count's son, Arpad, and the daughter of General Mariano Vallejo, Jovita's Selection Chardonnay is harvested from two sandstone soil vineyards in Sonoma, Gap's Crown and Durell Vineyards. The grapes were hand-harvested and whole cluster pressed and aged for 16 months in 30% new French oak before being bottled unfiltered.

TASTING NOTES

Toasted oak, jasmine and nectarine with a hint of minerality embrace the nose. The palate is soft, supple and well integrated. This 2019 Jovita's Chardonnay has fresh, intense flavors of green apple and nectarine sprinkled with a touch of honey. The finish is creamy, luxurious and lengthy.
