WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Named for Count Haraszthy's father who spent much of his adult life following his passion for wine - from cultivating vineyards to selling wine - Karoly's Selection Petite Sirah celebrates this unique varietal hailing from Southern France. Typically used as a blending grape, this dark, intense berry has strong tannins and dark fruit flavors.

TASTING NOTES

A dark color purple in the glass, dark fruit aromas greet the nose accented by notes of black tea. Layered flavors of blackberry, black cherry, dried blueberries and cocoa spread across the palate. Full bodied with dense and well-balanced tannins, this is a commanding wine with a savory finish.
