With its roots so deeply ensconced in the foundations of Sonoma where it was established in 1857, Buena Vista Winery is again introducing wines from the North Coast. These wines include a diverse array of varietals that celebrate the diversity of the North Coast's terroir and the contribution of Buena Vista to establishing the California wine world.

This enjoyable Pinot Noir is sourced from vineyards in Sonoma and Lake Counties, including vineyards in the Russian River Valley, Sonoma Coast, Sonoma Valley and Carneros – all part of California's distinctive North Coast appellation.

#### 2019 VINTAGE NOTES

Heavy spring rains enriched the soils and delayed bud break by a few weeks. A heat spike in June, followed by warm weather, brought even veraison throughout the vineyards. A cooling trend and touch of rain in mid-September created ideal conditions for the 2019 harvest which is considered a near-perfect vintage.

#### TASTING NOTES

Enticing aromas of raspberry, blueberry and sage leaf waft from the glass in this 2019 North Coast Pinot Noir. The intricate flavors of rich plum, strawberry and cardamom are balanced by notes of cocoa and an earthy characteristic. Nicely textured with smooth, plush tannins and an expansive mouthfeel this wine finishes long.
