The Vinicultural Society has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The Vinicultural Society explores noteworthy, obscure varietals, vineyards and the incredible terroir of Sonoma. VINTAGE NOTES

The 2019 vintage was a near picture-perfect growing season that began with warm temperatures to kick off the season and then mild temperatures for the slow development of the fruit. These mild temperatures created an extended hangtime developing balanced acidity and beautiful complexity.

TASTING NOTES

The Ribolla Gialla is a white Italian wine grape originally from northeastern part of Italy. The aromas of fresh orange zest, mango, and lemon arise from the glass. On the palate this wine is layered with hints of honey, apple crisp and fresh herbs. This dry medium-bodied wine has a luxurious, rich mouthfeel balanced with crisp acidity and a persistent finish.
