IN THE VINEYARD

At DeLoach Vineyards we strive to produce distinctive wines that highlight unique terroirs in a socially and environmentally responsible way, practicing sustainable viticulture and minimally intrusive winemaking. The fruit for this Pinot Noir was grown in a cool climate, allowing the grapes to ripen over an extended season to develop concentrated flavors. We selected fruit from some of the finest vineyards in the Russian River Valley, including our own estate vineyard and BCD Vineyard.

CONVERSATIONS WITH THE WINEMAKER

After the grapes for this O.F.S. Pinot Noir were hand-harvested and cluster sorted between September 7 - 27, they were open top fermented with native yeasts. The wine was gently basket-pressed and aged in French 10% new French oak barrels for 15 months prior to bottling. Each lot was individually fermented and aged before the winemaker tasted through to craft the finest blend.

TASTING NOTES

Powerful aromas of spice, red currants and a hint of rose spring from the glass in this 2019 Pinot Noir. Raspberry and dark cherry flavors are accented by notes of forest floor. This is a vibrant and refreshing wine with a nice fruity finish that lingers.
