The California Cabernet Sauvignon highlights the unique terroir of one of the world's top rated grape growing regions. Sourced from the Lodi, California Appellation and carefully harvested during ideal temperatures, this wine expresses well-structured and full-flavored characteristics.

The 2019 Lyeth California Cabernet Sauvignon has a touch of Petit Verdot for added layers of depth and complexity of flavor. A deep crimson in color with raspberry, boysenberry and black pepper aromas. Layers of Bing cherry, cocoa and a touch of minerality coat the palate. This wine has a nice tannin structure with a long and lingering finish.
