The California Cabernet Sauvignon highlights the unique terroir of one of the world's top rated grape growing regions. Sourced from the Lodi, California Appellation and carefully harvested during ideal temperatures, this wine expresses well-structured and full-flavored characteristics.

The 2020 Lyeth California Cabernet Sauvignon opens with a lovely bouquet of dark fruits including raspberry, blackberry and plum with a touch of earthiness. The medium-bodied palate showcases layers of cherry, boysenberry, black pepper, cocoa and a note of bay leaf. The finish is structured with a long finish.
