ABOUT THE VINTAGE

2020 kicked off with ideal growing conditions. Mild temperatures led to evenly developed clusters and an early budbreak was followed by a warm to hot summer. Low winter rains resulted in smaller berries with concentrated flavors. Harvest kicked off in early August and all things pointed to normal yields and exceptional fruit quality.

CONVERSATIONS WITH THE WINEMAKER

The grapes for this Rosé are grown throughout beautiful vineyards in Sonoma County, mostly in the Russian River Valley. The region's proximity to the bay with cool breezes and morning fog make it the perfect location for producing grapes with bright acidity and red berry flavors. The wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks to capture the lovely aromatics of the Pinot Noir grape.

WINE PROFILE

Our 2020 Sonoma County Rosé opens with enticing red fruit aromas of watermelon, strawberry and rose water. The palate is nicely textured with bright acidity and lively flavors of pomegranate and raspberry. The finish is refreshing and flavorful.
