The Private Reserve wines are the ultimate wines within the portfolio; limited in production, sourced from the finest vineyards in Sonoma County and from appellations best suited for a specific varietal given the dramatic diversity in climatic and soil conditions across the County.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The Private Reserve Zinfandel was sourced from several old vineyards across Sonoma County. Vineyards include White Perry, adjacent to Buena Vista Winery, Cohn in Dry Creek, Saitone and Boscetti in Russian River Valley and Richards located in the warmer portion of Sonoma Valley.

Open-top vats, hand punch downs, basket pressing and barrel aging are key components in the creation of this Zinfandel. After the grapes are hand-picked, the best lots were fermented separately being pressed off and aged 19 months in 100% French oak, 17% new.

TASTING NOTES

Immersed in a profound inky purple hue, the 2021 Private Reserve Zinfandel unveils a bouquet adorned with a wreath of Bing cherries, accompanied by a subtle essence of juniper berry. The palate is a canvas of expressions, where the freshness of blueberry, the warmth of baked plum, and the succulence of boysenberry intermingle seamlessly. This flavorful tapestry is further enriched by nuanced notes of allspice, anise, and a whisper of coffee. The palate experiences a luxurious embrace as silky, soft tannins elegantly layer, culminating in a mouthwatering finish that captivates the senses.
