IN THE VINEYARD

The fruit for our Vieilles Vignes Blanc is harvested from the heart of the cool Russian River Valley appellation from three distinctive vineyards: Ritchie, Ricioli and Fanucchi-Wood Road. The Ritchie Vineyard vines are over 40 years old and yield small clusters with ripe skins and concentrated flavors. The Ricioli Vineyard has an alluvial clay-loam soil composition and is planted to the Musque clone of Sauvignon Blanc lending floral aromas to the wine. Fanucchi-Wood Road is an organically grown and dry-farmed vineyard with the vines receiving great sun exposure resulting in bright fruit flavors.

CONVERSATIONS WITH THE WINEMAKER

The grapes were hand-harvested between August 31 and September 2 and were whole-cluster pressed and fermented in neutral oak barrels prior to bottling.

TASTING NOTES

Fresh floral aromas of lemon blossom and orange marmelade leap from the glass. Luxurious and refreshing flavors entice the palate with hints of white peach, pear and fresh-cut lime. This wine displays well-integrated acidity that lingers throughout the lengthy, crisp finish. A truly delightful and invigorating-white wine.
