ABOUT THE VINTAGE

2021 was a smooth and uneventful harvest season. June started out warm, followed by a cool and foggy July and August that slowed ripening and caused nice retention of acidity. Even ripening, with no extreme heat events, made for ideal growing conditions. Sparse winter rains resulted in an early budbreak, evenly developed clusters, and smaller berries packed full of flavor. Overall, the fruit was exceptional, making it another amazing year for quality.

CONVERSATIONS WITH THE WINEMAKER

This wine is a beautiful blend of prestigious north coast vineyards. High elevation vineyards with unique mountain climate conditions produce grapes with good acid retention during ripening. Neutral oak barrels were used during fermentation, capturing the vibrancy and freshness of this Cabernet Sauvignon.

WINE PROFILE

Our 2021 Family Classic North Coast Cabernet Sauvignon opens with bright aromas of plum, raspberry, strawberry and notes of bakers spice and eucalyptus. Medium to full-bodied, flavors of cherry, blueberry and mocha coat the palate with a touch of almond and layers of vanilla. Juicy on the finish with velvety tannins, this is a delicious wine.
