ABOUT THE VINTAGE

2021 was a smooth and uneventful harvest season. June started out warm, followed by a cool and foggy July and August that slowed ripening and caused nice retention of acidity. Even ripening, with no extreme heat events, made for ideal growing conditions. Sparse winter rains resulted in an early budbreak, evenly developed clusters, and smaller berries packed full of flavor. Overall, the fruit was exceptional, making it another amazing year for quality.

CONVERSATIONS WITH THE WINEMAKER

The grapes for this Rosé are grown throughout beautiful vineyards in the Napa Valley, mostly in the Carneros Region. This region is known for its extended sunny growing season, minimal rain and cooler winters that help the grapes ripen evenly, providing bright acidity and red berry flavors. The wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks for eight months to capture the lovely aromatics of the Pinot Noir grape.

WINE PROFILE

Our 2021 Napa Valley Rosé opens with bright, fresh fruit aromas of guava, peach and watermelon. The palate is pleasant and delightful with fresh acidity enhanced by flavors of raspberry and nectarine. The finish is well-balanced and refreshing.
