#### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This unique varietal was once the most widely planted white grape in the south of France and The wine was aged in concrete which lends texture and softening along with a sense of minerality.

#### TASTING NOTES

Extremely light and translucent in hue, the nose presents fragrant hints of pineapple, key lime, and mint. Vibrant notes of lemongrass, kaffir lime, and green plum envelop the palate, striking a harmonious equilibrium between sweetness and tartness. The mouthfeel is impeccably balanced and seamlessly integrated, leading to a delightful, crisp, and enduring finish.
