The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Northern California.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Named for Count Haraszthy's wife, Eleanor's Selection Chardonnay is harvested from vineyards across the North Coast. The grapes were hand picked on the early morning of September 25 and were whole cluster pressed into French oak barrels, 30% new, aged on the lies for 16 months before bottling.

TASTING NOTES

This elegant, well-balanced wine features vibrant green apple and tangy lemon zest flavors, uplifted by soft notes of silky vanilla cream and roasted almond. The wine gracefully blends with refined touches of acidity, offering a smooth, polished texture that leads to a rich, indulgent finish.
