IN THE VINEYARD

The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society was formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy, to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards. The Vinicultural Society has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The collection of wines explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Northern California.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The grapes for this Grenache Blanc were harvested on September 28, 2022, from Sonoma Valley in Sonoma County. The moderately cool climate found in the Sonoma Valley AVA allows for a longer growing season which in turn, helps maximize flavors and increase concentration while, the cooler temperatures, preserve the grapes' natural acidity. The grapes were fermented with native yeast before being aged in neutral French oak barrels for nine months.

TASTING NOTES

As the 2022 Grenache Blanc graces the glass, one is captivated by its straw-hued elegance tinged with subtle green undertones. Delight in the bouquet that unfolds, revealing notes of toasted nuts, nuanced cumin, fragrant nutmeg, a hint of dill, and the delicate essence of anise. The freshness of underbrush gracefully gives way to an aromatic symphony featuring white flowers, succulent yellow peach, zesty tangerine, and a whisper of subtle mineral undertones. This is a luscious and full-bodied wine.
