## VINICULTURE SOCIETY

The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society was formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy, to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards. ## VINTAGE NOTES

The start of the 2022 growing season was marked by favorable weather conditions extending into the early summer months. However, the situation shifted as a prolonged heatwave emerged in late August, hastening the harvesting process and leading to diminished yields for certain grape varieties.

## TASTING NOTES

The Ribolla Gialla is a white Italian wine grape originally from the northeastern part of Italy. From the glass, wafting aromas of ripened citrus, tropical fruit, and freshly squeezed lemon create an inviting embrace. On the palate, layers unfold, revealing the delightful interplay of honeycomb, baked apple, and a hint of allspice. With a medium-bodied presence, this wine exudes a magnificent, creamy mouthfeel harmoniously balanced by bright acidity, culminating in a long and lingering finish that adds a lasting touch of elegance.
