The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Northern California.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The grapes for this Roussanne were harvested on September 12, 2022, from Bennett Valley in Sonoma County. The moderately cool climate found in the Bennett Valley AVA allows for a longer growing season which in turn, helps maximize flavors and increase concentration while, the cooler temperatures, preserve the grapes' natural acidity. The grapes were fermented with native yeast before being aged in neutral French oak barrels for eight months.

TASTING NOTES

Welcoming you with open arms, this wine envelops your senses in notes of baked peach and lilac, intricately layered with a touch of orange blossom and lemon zest. Exhibiting a medium-bodied profile, the white wine unfolds its crisp flavors of stone fruit, subtly accented by hints of crème brûlée. Invigorating and fresh, it dances on the palate with crisp acidity and a soft, lush mouthfeel, leaving an irresistible desire for another sip.
