The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society was formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy, to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards. The Vinicultural Society has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The collection of wines explores clonal selections, varieties and the incredible terroir of Sonoma County.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Named for the wife of the Count's son Attila and the daughter of General Mariano Vallejo, Natalia's selection Chardonnay is harvested from the Green Valley region of the Russian River Valley, where the warm summer days and cool nights of the region allowed the select blocks to reach optimum ripeness and flavor maturity. The grapes for our 2023 Chardonnay were harvested in the early morning to retain freshness. The wine underwent 100% malolactic fermentation and was aged in 100% French oak, 32% new, for 18 months prior to bottling on April 1, 2025.

TASTING NOTES

The 2023 Chardonnay Natalia's Selection leaps from the glass with a captivating bouquet of fragrant jasmine, warm chai spice, caramelized apple, and whispers of sun-kissed tropical fruit. Lush and velvety on the palate, it delivers lively brightness and concludes with a delicate, creamy almond finish. This is an enchantingly elegant Chardonnay.
