## CABERNET SAUVIGNON MOUNT VEEDER

VINTAGE 2018

### IN THE VINEYARD

The fruit for our Mount Veeder cabernet sauvignon came from an historic Napa Ranch, Brandlin with 180 degree views from St. Helena to the San Pablo Bay, Hillside, Clone 337.

### WINEMAKING

The 2018 growing season was smooth and long with plenty of rainfall during the winter to keep the vines healthy. At the Brandlin vineyard, an inversion layer provided and end-of-season catch up. The grapes were picked on October 23 and produced in 20% new French oak barrels.

### TASTING NOTES

Rich, vibrant and dark ink in color. Aromas are lively and intense with a hint of fresh violets. Deep cherry, black plum and caramel with hints of dried sage and cedar are expressed on the palate of this extraordinary wine from Mount Veeder.
