IN THE VINEYARD

From Napa's Northernmost AVA this Calistoga vineyard, Kenefick Ranch is in a canyon created by two alluvial fans, made up of volcanic origin soils that range from rock, to cobble, to gravel, and have little organic matter which adds concentration to the fruit.

WINEMAKING

Harvested by hand on October 14 the grapes were then hand-sorted and placed into small open-top fermentation tanks. Each lot was kept separate until blending. Following fermentation, the wine was transferred into French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Dark ruby in color with delightful aromas of blackberry, raspberry and strawberry. This is a refined, elegant and expressive wine. Notes of black plum and wild blueberries are highlighted with a silky and soft palate. The finish is well-balanced with complex and integrated tannins creating a creamy, luscious and long finish.
