IN THE VINEYARD

The fruit comes from the Dorn Vineyard rich in experience as they have been farming grapes since 1965. The vineyard is perched on a hillside overlooking Clear Lake in the North Coast AVA; so steep tractors can't be used for harvest, which is done using pullies. The vineyard is largely composed of volcanic soils.

WINEMAKING

Our 2021 sauvignon blanc consists of five vineyards selected from sites that showcase the minerality and fresh fruit that is a mark of Elizabeth Spencer wines. All lots were fermented separately at cool temperatures, then blended together to craft a bright, and approachable wine. We bottled here in our Napa Valley winery after an early harvest this year to capture the fragrance and zesty acidity that were a highlight of the 2020 growing season.

TASTING NOTES

Light gold in color with extraordinary aromas of fresh apricot, pear and a touch of tropical fruit. This delightful wine expresses notes of peach, vanilla biscuit and a luxurious array of white flowers. The finish is well-integrated and seductive leaving you with the desire for more.
