GRAPE VARIETY: Petite Sirah and Cabernet Sauvignon

REGION: Napa Valley (St. Helena), California

WINEMAKING NOTES: Aged in 18-19 months in French oak - 19% new French (Baron, Demptos, Radoux). Fermentation (all extended maceration), the Petite Sirah was pressed off after 29 days and the Cabernet Sauvignon after 40 days. Petite Sirah was harvested on a root day and the Cabernet Sauvignon on a flower day; bottled on a leaf day. Vegan, bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.

Alcohol: 15% | pH: 3.60 | T/A: 6.3 g/L

TASTING NOTES: Crafted with boldness and power, this wine is an exquisite marriage of Petite Sirah sourced from the organic and biodynamic vineyards of the Raymond Estate where the heavier soils help bring out the firmness of its tannins, while the Cabernet Sauvignon hails from the west side of the renowned St. Helena region. Cloaked in a dark, majestic purple robe, this wine exudes an unwavering intensity, delivering flavors of profoundly concentrated red and black fruits, punctuated by subtle whispers of spice and cedar. This opulent blend culminates in a colossal finish that lingers indefinitely, promising the potential for graceful aging over the years.

WHAT KNOCKOUT SIGNIFIES: An intense, rich and impactful bottle of wine, Knockout will steal the show. The uncommon pairing of intense and rich Petite Sirah with the plushness of Cabernet Sauvignon is a winning combination!

For Jean-Charles, the boldness of the Knockout will stand up to any challenger and win any fight. It is powerful while being graceful; it is quick to please but also has enough strength to last well into the night!
