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**GRAPE VARIETY:** Cabernet Sauvignon

**REGION:** Napa Valley, California

**WINEMAKING NOTES:** Aged 18-19 months in 100% French oak

- fermentation on skins for an average of 38 days
- Alcohol: 15.5%
- pH: 3.75
- T/A: 6.3 g/L

**TASTING NOTES:** Our 2020 Napa Valley Cabernet strikes a remarkable jewel-toned purple in the glass and opens with lovely aromas of baked plums and cherries, with a touch of cinnamon and rich earth. N° 10 is a blend of two vineyards, with 60% from Oakville and 40% from Rutherford. Firm and velvety tannins are complimented by bold freshness leading into a long red-fruit finish, with a hint of minerality..

**WHAT THE NUMBER 10 SIGNIFIES:** The number 10 throughout history has always represented the concept of wholeness, soundness and being complete. This wine was uniquely designed to represent all that Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is renowned for: structure, balance and power. It is a perfect 10!

For Jean-Charles Boisset, the N° 10 Cabernet Sauvignon must not only age well into the future, it must be DECADENT in the present. It must have a commanding structure, yet have flavors that are HEDONISTIC. But above all, N° 10 must always have a dramatic personality. It is never tamed and predictable. N° 10 is NOBLE.
