WINEMAKING NOTES: Aged 18-19 months in small French oak barrels - 48% new French (Demptos, La Grange). Fermentation (all extended maceration) on skins for 32 days.
Bottled unfinned and unfiltered
Alcohol: 15.5%

TASTING NOTES: This vintage is entirely sourced from St. Helena and dazzles with a brilliant, purple jewel-tone in the glass. N°10 offers an inviting bouquet of roasted plums, a touch of baking spices, and luxurious earthy undertones. Resolute and strong in character, this wine showcases plush tannins and a bold, revitalizing freshness that lingers on the palate.

WHAT THE NUMBER 10 SIGNIFIES: The number 10 throughout history has always represented the concept of wholeness, soundness and being complete. This wine was uniquely designed to represent all that Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is renowned for: structure, balance and power. It is a perfect 10!

For Jean-Charles Boisset, the N° 10 Cabernet Sauvignon must not only age well into the future, it must be DECADENT in the present. It must have a commanding structure, yet have flavors that are HEDONISTIC. But above all, N° 10 must always have a dramatic personality. It is never tamed and predictable. N° 10 is NOBLE.
