TASTING NOTES: Ripe, dark red fruit, plums, cherries and exotic spices of nutmeg and black cardamom entice you on the nose. On the palate, you are greeted with candied walnuts and bakers chocolate. The wine coats your mouth with a wide, velvety texture which leads you to a bright finish.

WHAT THE NUMBER 6 SIGNIFIES: In honor of the very first JCB wine, a California Pinot Noir from the 2006 vintage, N°6 pays tribute to the inception of a grand collection of boutique wines destined to set a new standard epitomizing luxury and style.
