WINEMAKING NOTES: This rosé is made in the saignée method by carrying out a short maceration of Pinot Noir from Burgundy's côtes. Dosage: 10 g/L

TASTING NOTES: N°69 is a seductively light and refreshing rosé. Vibrant aromas of raspberry and red currant evolve into aromatic jammy notes. This wine is tender in the mouth with crisp flavors.

WHAT THE NUMBER 69 SIGNIFIES: N°69 – does it really need explanation? – is inspired by the year of Jean-Charles' birth – 1969, the year that mankind went to the moon! It is a symbol of expression, freedom, creativity, intellectual revolution, artistry and refinement. Of course, N°69 is also a Pinot Noir Brut Rosé that entwines masculinity and femininity.



Our dry Rosé N°69 sparkling wine is not a dainty pink thing. It's a FLAMBOYANT, profound mouthful of serious bubbles. The VIBRANT crispness of N°69 is thirst quenching. Yet the flavors—evocative of Pinot Noir—are beautifully SENSUAL.
