## WHITE BORDEAUX BLEND

Grape Variety: Semillon and Sauvignon Blanc

Vintage : 2012

Region: Napa Valley, California

Winemaking Notes: Barrel fermented and barrel aged in 10% new oak for 14 months.

Tasting Notes: Delightful aromas of lemon meringue, vanilla, fig leaf and kiwi. Refreshing flavors of honey dew melon and clementine.

What The Number 16 Signifies: Each JCB wine is known by a number. And each number has deep significance for Jean-Charles Boisset, the collection's creator and name sake. Jean-Charles grew up in Burgundy, France and at the age of 16 he visited the Bordeaux region for the first time. He forever remembers the first taste of the crisp white wine blends and it inspired the creation of No. 16, an extraordinary Napa Valley white wine blend.
