Winemaking Notes:

- The juice spent 26 days on the skin, then cold soaked for just under 4 days. It went through active fermentation, then sat for another 9-12 days on extended maceration prior to draining and pressing.
- Aged in 100% French oak
 - 60% new oak
 - Medium plus toast
- 600 bottles produced

Tasting Notes:

- Color: Deep plum.
- Aromas: Vibrant and feminine with lots of floral notes and perfume.
- Palate: Notes of white pepper, plum, cassis and blueberry are soft yet vibrant, with a silky entry. Hints of black currant, warm toasted hazelnuts, white chocolate and amaretto fill the palate. The juicy tannins and long finish leave you wanting more...it's incurrrible.
