### Grape Variety:

80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 16% Merlot, 4% Petit Verdot

### Region:

Napa Valley

### Winemaking Notes:

- Aged in 100% French oak
  - 65% new oak
  - 18 months
- 100 cases produced

### The Source:

The Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot come from a Napa hillside vineyard just south of the Stags Leap District with volcanic ash soils. The Cabernet is planted to the Oakville Ranch Selection clone and the Petit Verdot is planted to the Gemstone Selection clone. The Merlot is clone 181 and is harvested from a vineyard in Coombsville with a mix of volcanic ash and gravelly loam soils.

### Why "N° 1":

The N° 1 signifies Jean-Charles' concept of the penultimate wine. A wine that embraces the power of Napa Valley with the elegance of his native Burgundy. There can only truly ever be one **N° 1**.
