## PINOT NOIR

**Grape Variety:** 100% Pinot Noir

**Vintage:** 2012

**Region:** Sonoma Coast, Sonoma County, California

**Winemaking Notes:** Aged for 12 months in French Oak barrels, 33% new oak.

**Tasting Notes:** Elegant aromas of black cherry, plum sauce and worchestershire complimented by flavors of blackberries, black pepper, boysenberry and dark chocolate-covered coffee beans.

**What The Number 22 Signifies:** Each JCB wine is known by a number. And each number has deep significance for Jean-Charles Boisset, the collection's creator and namesake. No. 22 represents the number eleven twice, and 11 is Jean-Charles' lucky number. No. 22 was chosen because this wine has twice the intensity, grandeur and charisma of most Pinot Noirs.
