Tasting Notes: This limited production wine is a blend of Petite Sirah from Rutherford and Cabernet Sauvignon from St Helena. It is a bold and intense wine, with a full body and rich, mouth coating palate. With notes of violet, dark berries and baking spices, you will want to dive right into the glass. Dark purple in color, the palate continues to present notes of dark berries, graham cracker crust and hints of black pepper. This unfinned and unfiltered wine should age well in your cellar for many years to come!

What Knockout Signifies: An intense, rich and impactful bottle of wine, Knockout will steal the show. This delectable wine gets its power and strength from a core of Petite Sirah which is spicy and intense in the glass, while the Cabernet Sauvignon adds finesse and grace. The uncommon pairing of intense and rich Petite Sirah with the plushness of Cabernet Sauvignon is a winning combination!
