Grape Variety: Petite Sirah & Cabernet Sauvignon

Region: Napa Valley

Winemaking Notes:

Fermented in small stainless steel tanks

Aged in 100% French oak

- 70% new oak

- aged for 20 months



Tasting Notes: This bold and powerful wine is a blend of Petite Sirah from Rutherford and Cabernet Sauvignon from St Helena. This wine, dark purple in color, brings the intensity with its flavors of baker's chocolate, bramble dark berries, and hints of white pepper. The palate continues with big notes of blue and black berries with hints of earthiness that all come together with balanced tannins. This bold and tense red blend will age well with years.

What Knockout Signifies: An intense, rich and impactful bottle of wine, Knockout will steal the show. This delectable wine gets its power and strength from a core of Petite Sirah which is spicy and intense in the glass, while the Cabernet Sauvignon adds finesse and grace. The uncommon pairing of intense and rich Petite Sirah with the plushness of Cabernet Sauvignon is a winning combination!
