The Source:

The Cabernet Franc was harvested from an esteemed vineyard on Pritchard Hill while the Cabernet Sauvignon was harvested from a vineyard in western St. Helena along Inglewood Avenue. The berries were harvested from October 11th through the 21st and were fermented on skins for 28 days.

Why "N° 17":

Cabernet Franc was first established in the 17th century by the polarizing Cardinal Richelieu, when he transplanted cuttings to the Loire valley to be planted at the Abbey of Bourgueil.
