Grape Variety: 100% Pinot Noir

Region: Sonoma Coast

Winemaking Notes:

- Aged in 100% French oak
- 30% new barrels
- aged for 15 months

Tasting Notes: Fermented in open-top, wooden fermenters with hand punch downs, this Pinot Noir is full and rich from start to finish. The wine presents as a deep, rich, vibrant red in the glass. You are greeted with dark fruit, black cherry, and plum sauce on the nose and the pallet, with a hint of orange peel. The rich finish is very long, luscious and full bodied.

What The Number 22 Signifies: N°22 represents the number eleven twice, and 11 is Jean-Charles' lucky number. N°22 was chosen because this wine has twice the intensity, grandeur and charisma of most Pinot Noirs.

For Jean-Charles Boisset, the supple texture of a great Pinot Noir makes drinking it an almost **INTIMATE** experience. Earthy and powerful, N°22 is a **TUMULTUOUS** riot of deep flavors. We think of it as insistent and **INTENSE**.
