Sultry • Timeless • Flirtatious

Grape Variety: 100% Pinot Noir

Region: Russian River Valley

Winemaking Notes:

Aged in 100% French oak
-15 months in barrel

Tasting Notes: The Pinot Noir grapes for the JCB N° 6 come from vineyards in the southern Russian River Valley which lend dark, rich notes to the wine, and from the Olivet Bench area in the middle of the Russian River Valley which provide the core of this wine with notes of red fruit and earth. On the nose you are greeted with red raspberry, red cherry, graham cracker crust and hints of recently bloomed lavender. The palate is dense and rich, introducing notes of umami, and darker notes of baked cherry and stewed strawberries. The mouthfeel is bright and bold, with a long mouth-coating finish.

What The Number 6 Signifies: In honor of the very first JCB wine a California Pinot Noir from the 2006 vintage, N° 6 pays tribute to the inception of a grand collection of boutique wines destined to set a new standard epitomizing luxury and style.

Pinot Noir, to Jean-Charles Boisset, is a **TIMELESS** pleasure to always be enjoyed. A bit **FLIRTATIOUS** in the glass, our N° 6 Pinot Noir celebrates the **SULTRY** nature of this elegant varietal.
