Grape Variety: 100% Pinot Noir

Region: Sonoma Coast

Winemaking Notes:

- Aged in 100% French oak - 60% new barrels – aged for 15 months
- 100 cases produced
- 14.5% ABV

Tasting Notes: The JCB N°7 grabs you immediately with its dark cherry liqueur nose. With notes of bacon fat and smoke, intermingled with earthiness and rich fruit, it is a perfectly complex bottle of Pinot Noir to pair with food. The mouthfeel opens with silky, soft tannins, that transition to a full and long body. This wine has beautiful, high acidity, typical of the Sonoma coast.

What The Number 7 Signifies: N°7 symbolizes the time when Jean-Charles, at the age of 7, snuck a few tastes of some older Burgundies that his parents were serving at a party. For Jean-Charles, the experience not only developed his palate, but the seed was planted for his lifetime's passion and work.

Jean Charles Boisset believes that no grape demonstrates the affinity between wine and style like Pinot Noir. N°7, for example, is what the French call **DEBONNAIRE** – meaning it has an easy, stylish charm. But at the same time, N°7 is not a shy Pinot Noir. Its forward fruit is **CHARISMATIC**. And its mouth-filling, earthy flavors, coupled with its silky texture, makes it downright **SEDUCTIVE**.
