Tasting Notes: A plush and enticing red wine, this 2017 Malbec offers vibrant aromas of black plum, all spice, and espresso. On the palate flavors of reduced blackberry, baker's chocolate, and boysenberry are complimented by hints of sandalwood. Both dark fruit and savory forward in profile, this rich wine has supple yet refined tannins, and a satisfying finish.

What The Number 68 Signifies: In 1868 a new grape from Old World France was brought across the treacherous seas to the New World in Argentina: Malbec. This foray into the New World brought about new chances for creative expression and passion to arise and be celebrated. In the same way, Jean-Charles ventured across the ocean to ignite his creative passions and to craft exquisite wines that unite the Old and New worlds.
